# Columbia West College

If the Enrollment Agreement is cancelled, the school will refund you any money you have paid within 45 days after the notice of cancellation is received or the first scheduled day of class, whichever is earlier, less an application fee of \$150.00, any non-refundable charges listed in the Enrollment Agreement and any deduction for equipment not returned in good condition.
